



Recycling Homework



We are going to be learning about how to reduce, reuse, and recycle materials in order to help save the earth. We would like each child to create something at home, from something out of your recycling bin. Here are a few suggestions:

Plastic milk jugs can be turned into piggy banks, or baskets, or cut into flying pteradactyls or airplanes (leave the handle on so they can hold on and make it fly up and down!)

Soup cans can be turned into pencil holders, or kitchen utensil holders, or decorated as animals.

Newspapers can be folded into hats, or animals, or palm trees.

Completing homework and remembering to bring it to school is an increasingly important part of education. Please be sure your child participates in the decision and creation of this project.

The completed projects should be brought to school on Friday, April 30. We plan to have a Kindergarten Recycling Parade to show off our handiwork. Because we have no good display area for the creations, they will be returned home the same day. Please make sure your child's item is labeled with his or her name.
