Raises head slightly off bed	1 month	Makes noises in throat
Holds head erect, responds to smile	2 months	Vocalizes
Lifts head & chest Improved head control	3 months	Coos and chuckles
Rolls side to side, takes object Enjoys play, good head control	4 months	Laughs aloud
Sits with minimal support Rolls from stomach to back Transfers object hand to hand	6 months	Babbles using more than 2 sounds
Sits alone, changes position without falling, plays with 2 objects at once Unwraps block	9 months	Says mama – baba
Pulls self to stand, step with support Picks up things with fingers & thumb Stacks 2 blocks	1 year	Follows simple directions accompanied by gestures Follows simple directions May say 2-3 words
May walk without support Some self feeding	15 months	Vocalizes, voice up and down like conversation Says 4 – 5 words
Walks, may run Makes mark with crayon Climbs up and down 1 stair Partially feeds self	18 months	Likes being read to May say 5 – 10 words
Kicks large ball Turns pages 2-3 at a time Imitates house work Knows when familiar pictures are upside down	2 years	Asks for items by name Uses 2-3 word sentences "more juice"
Walks up stairs, hops in place Stands momentarily on 1 foot Feeds self, opens door	3 years	Verbalizes toilet needs
Copies circle Throws and catches ball Points to basic colors	4 years	Knows name, sex, age Uses sentences with correct grammar
Walks backward heel to toe Plays with others Recognizes printed name Prints letters	5 years	Responds verbally to Hi, how are you?
