

BLOCK-O-SAURUS

Parents and children work together to build a dinosaur out of blocks. Think up a name for the dinosaur you created.

Use the school camera to take a digital picture of your child and the Block-o-saurus.

Please “un-build” your dinosaur so someone else can use the blocks when you are done.

BRONTOSAURUS BOATS

Pick up a recording sheet.
Put one boat into the water at a time.
Carefully put small dinosaurs into the
boat, count to see how many
dinosaurs you can fit into the boat
before it tips. Mark that on the
recording sheet.

Read the directions and mark which
boat held the most, the least, etc.

Be sure to take all the boats and
dinosaurs out of the water before you
walk away.

ICE AGE AMPHIBIANS

Choose a dinosaur. Sprinkle a very small amount of powdered Kool-ade on the dinosaur.

Rub an ice cube over the Kool-ade powder to make a design.

Take it to your own classroom to let it dry in your mailbox.

FIGURE WITH FOSSILS

Let's pretend we are prehistoric people who use dinosaur bones to measure with.

Take a recording sheet and use the small white dino bones to measure each item.

Write the correct number of bones next to each item.

Talk with your grown up about which item took more bones, which took less, etc. Please do not take any bones with you.
